Beyond paying for your meal, you can expect to encounter a few DoorDash fees with every order. On-demand food delivery services never come for free, but when you're ordering from the DoorDash fees with every order. If the actual total ends up being higher, you only pay the estimated price, which means you luck out with an unofficial discount. Delivery Fee DoorDash, as you probably expect, charges a delivery fee with every delivery request. This fee usually ranges from \$1.99 to \$5.99, though the exact charge will depend on the restaurant you select. Like Uber Eats and other delivery apps, DoorDash does raise this fee during times of high demand. According to the brand, DoorDash peak hours usually occur during lunch and dinner, from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. and from 4 p.m. to 9 p.m. Customers do have ongoing opportunities to save on DoorDash delivery fees though. As of May 2020, all new customers automatically get free delivery on all orders over \$10 for their first 30 days, just for signing up.
